"I KNOW WHO I AM NOW... A NEW CREATION."

Robby grew up in a home with absent parents and domestic violence. As a teen he was removed from his home and adopted into a new family. Still feeling alone, he accepted an invitation to try drugs, and soon became addicted.

"I turned into a person that kept running from everything – feelings, relationships, even myself," he said.

After leaving home and spending years struggling with addiction, Robby stayed in our overnight shelter at our sister Mission, the Jersey Shore Rescue Mission. He decided to join the addiction recovery program, but after a few months he left to address some medical issues. Life caught up with him again.

"I was trying to hold it together and couldn't. I slipped into a deep depression and lost direction."

He checked himself into the hospital, and there he knew he needed to go back to the Mission. "I was willing to do anything," he said.

When Robby rejoined our Life Change Program at the Market Street Mission, he grew tremendously. Through work therapy, classes and Bible studies, he deepened his relationship with God and began learning who he was created to be.

Through the encouragement of the community he has found – and thanks to your prayers and support! – **Robby is filled with undeniable joy and hope for the future.** He graduated from our program, got baptized and now serves as a program intern at the Jersey Shore Rescue Mission!

In his leadership position, he is excited to help others through the struggles he once faced. He is also going to school to become a social worker. Through it all, his goal is to glorify God.

Robby is thankful for the way you have answered God's calling to love your neighbor as yourself – and have opened the door for him to learn how to love himself and experience new life. "The path that God has set before me is going to be incredible. I've got a new life, completely, and I know who I am now. *I am a new creation.*"
