


AN UPDATE FOR YOU FROM THE MARKET STREET MISSION





"Because I had space to do what I wanted, I found ways to manipulate the situation, and I started drinking."

What started as an occasional activity became excessive when he joined the military. Eventually, his substance use strained his marriage, leading to divorce.

Anthony continued providing for his family and raising his daughters, but as they grew and started their own families, his drinking left them worried.

But one day, he had a moment of clarity: this lifestyle was not healthy. There had to be more to life.

Through chapel services, life skills classes and guidance, he began to heal. Over time, he discovered what "life change program" really meant – not just obtaining sobriety, but learning to be the man God created him to be. "Being in a faith-based program helped me tremendously."

Because of your kindness and faithful prayers, Anthony graduated from our program and was chosen to serve in a leadership position as a Mission Intern! He is a mentor to other men in our program and hopes to attend college to study counseling.

You're sharing God's love this summer.


